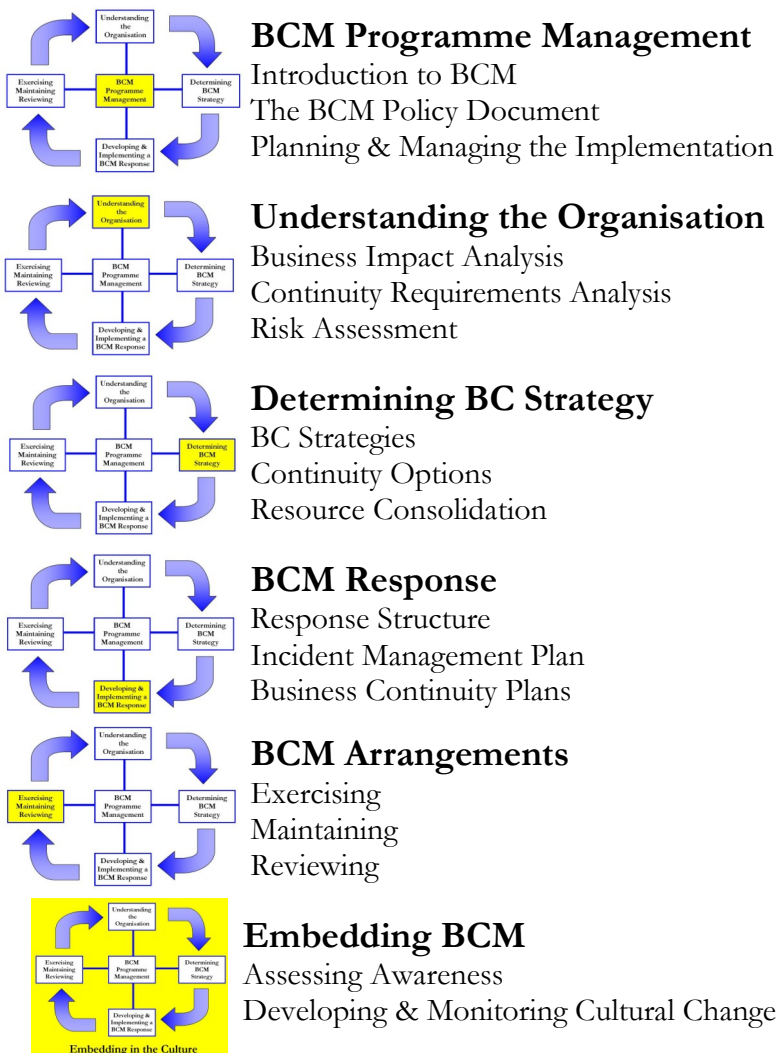


# Implementing BCM

This four day workshop provides a practical guide to implementing Business Continuity Management (BCM), and is suitable for organisations that need to train their staff in the theory and practice of Business Continuity Management (BCM). It is aimed at those who will be involved in, or will be managing, the implementation of the BCM programme. No prior knowledge of the subject is required.

## Structure

The structure of the course follows the six sections of the Business Continuity Institute's Good Practice Guidelines (GPG), and uses a mixture of presentation and breakout sessions where the delegates work on a case study.



## Objectives

The objectives are to teach the delegates the theory of BCM as presented in the GPG, and how to put the theory into practice to achieve a successful implementation of BCM.

## Case Study

The case study used in the workshop involves the implementation of BCM in a fictitious organisation, and each breakout session covers a key deliverable from the BCM life-cycle, building up to provide the delegates with a complete practical view of the implementation of a BCM programme.

## Customisation

As with all Merrycon's training workshops, Implementing BCM can be tailored to suit the individual needs of the client. In particular, the case study can be substituted for the client's own organisation, which enables the client to produce material that will be of use in the client's implementation of BCM.
