

Introduction to Business Continuity

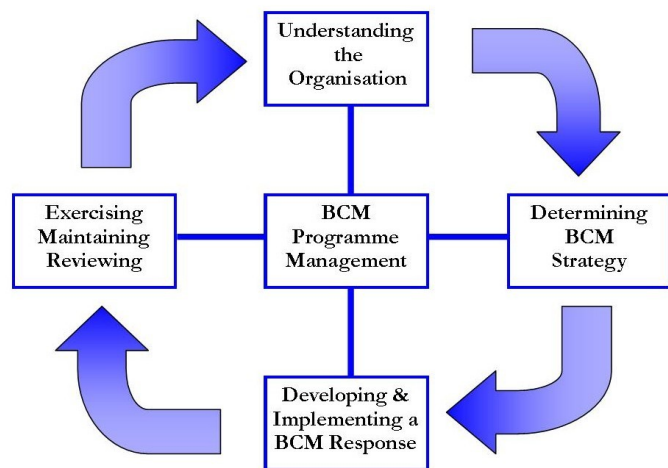
Those attending the workshop will be provided with an overview of the Business Continuity process, and will learn:

The workshop takes the delegates through the BCM life-cycle that is to be found in the Business Continuity Institute's Good Practice Guidelines and the British Standard Institute's BS 25999.

Delegates will learn about the practical difficulties in implementing BCM, and the measures that can be put in place to overcome these difficulties.

A key feature of this workshop is the use of plain English to explain the jargon of that is used by many Business Continuity practitioners.



The structure of the course workshop uses a mixture of presentation and breakout sessions in which the delegates explore the ideas, concepts, and techniques of Business Continuity in the context of their own organisation.

The breakout sessions cover the key stages and deliverables of the BCM life-cycle, building up to provide the delegates with a complete practical overview of an initial implementation of the process.
